- ◆ Member \$50 a year with a \$5 daily charge every time you use the Range

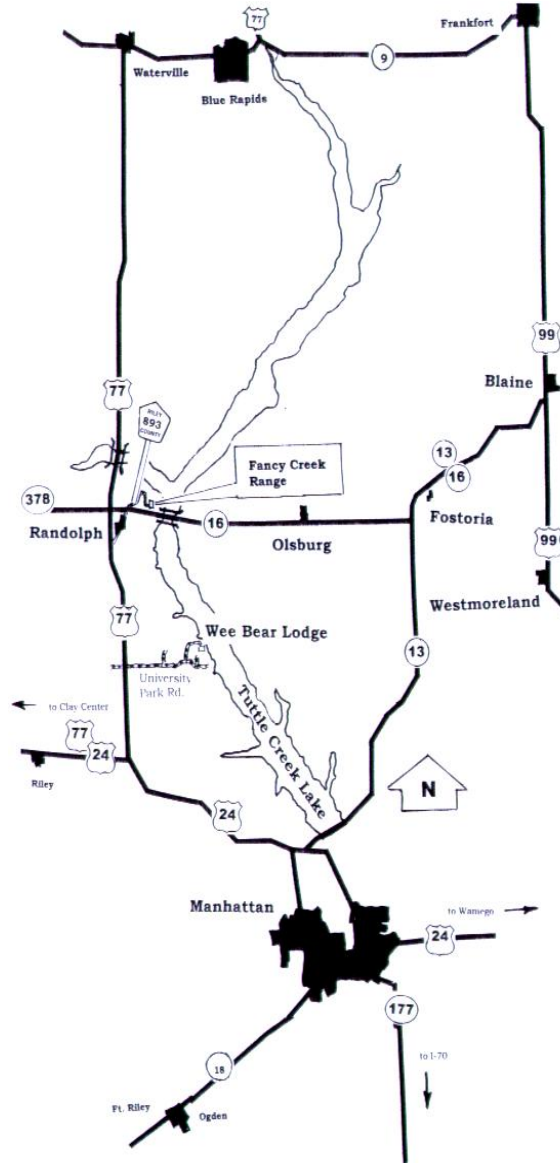

Mission Statement

To establish a safe shooting environment for the general public and families that could also be utilized to improve Hunter Education, 4-H Shooting Sports, Scouting, Women's programs and other Youth groups.

History of the Range

- ◆ In the early 1990's planning started for the Range
- ◆ FFCR is a spinoff of Riley County Fish & Game Association
- ◆ Range site was selected through cooperation of the Army Corps of Engineers and Kansas Department of Wildlife and Parks
- ◆ Funding to construct the Range came from the money generated by the Pittman-Robertson Act, a Federal tax on sporting goods including firearms, ammunition, and archery equipment
- ◆ The Range was opened in September 2002
- ◆ Electricity was made available to the Range by Westar's Green Team in 2007

Volunteers

- ◆ The Range is operated by volunteers
- ◆ Each Range has a NRA Certified Range Safety Officer working when the Range is operational
- ◆ Our Range would not be open without all of our volunteers

Rifle Range

- ◆ 20 Firing Points
- ◆ Shooting available at 50 meters and 100 meters



Pistol Range

- ◆ 9 Firing Points
- ◆ Shooting available at 10 meters and 22 meters
- ◆ Shooting at 7 meters upon request on lanes 4, 5 and 6



50 Meter Range

- ◆ Our goal is to build a 50 meter multi-functional Range
- ◆ We are raising money to finance its completion
- ◆ To date we have received construction grants from the National Wild Turkey Federation, the Justin Corbet Shooting Foundation, the NRA Foundation but we need additional funds to complete the Range

Children's Event at the Range

- ◆ Event is scheduled for June 12, 2010
- ◆ Instructional shooting clinic providing .22 rifles, BB Gun, black powder, archery and much more for children age 8 – 15
